

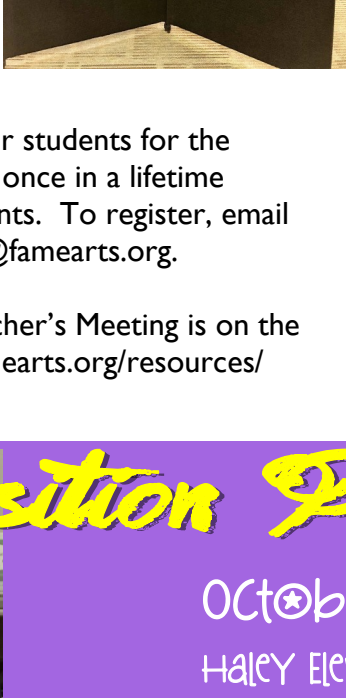

A once in a lifetime experience in music composition

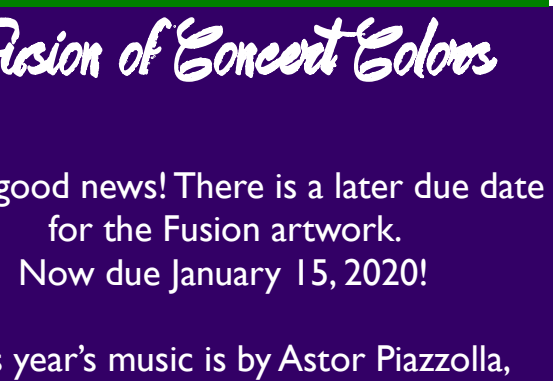

FAME is inviting your classroom to make ornaments for the FAME Tree at the Embassy Theatre's Annual Festival of Trees

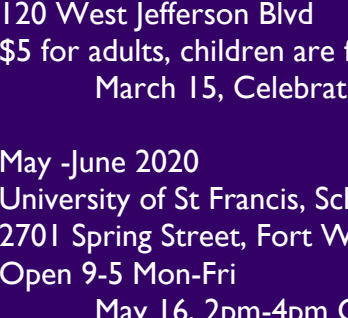


With the FAME Cultural Focus South & Central America just use your imagination and get creative!

Please limit the number of ornaments to 1 classroom per school

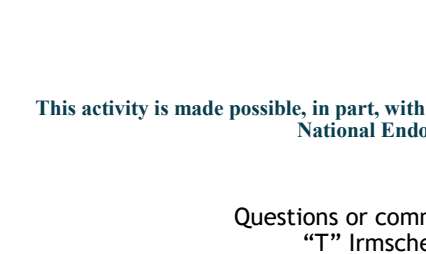
Ornaments are due at the FAME office by 5pm on November 8, 2019

Fusion of Concert Colors

More good news! There is a later due date for the Fusion artwork. Now due January 15, 2020!

This year's music is by Astor Piazzolla, "The worlds foremost composer of tango music."

How to get started with Fusion of Concert Colors? The first step-familiarize the children with the music. The music teacher (or the art teacher) should take some time with the students listening to the music and discussing its musical form. They should discuss the similarities between musical composition and visual composition. For example, in music there is generally a dominant melody which is repeated throughout the piece, sometimes directly and sometimes as a variation. In the visual art piece, it is important to **develop a theme either in shapes or colors or lines** then to **repeat and vary that theme** throughout the entire composition. Both musical and visual **compositions are balanced**.

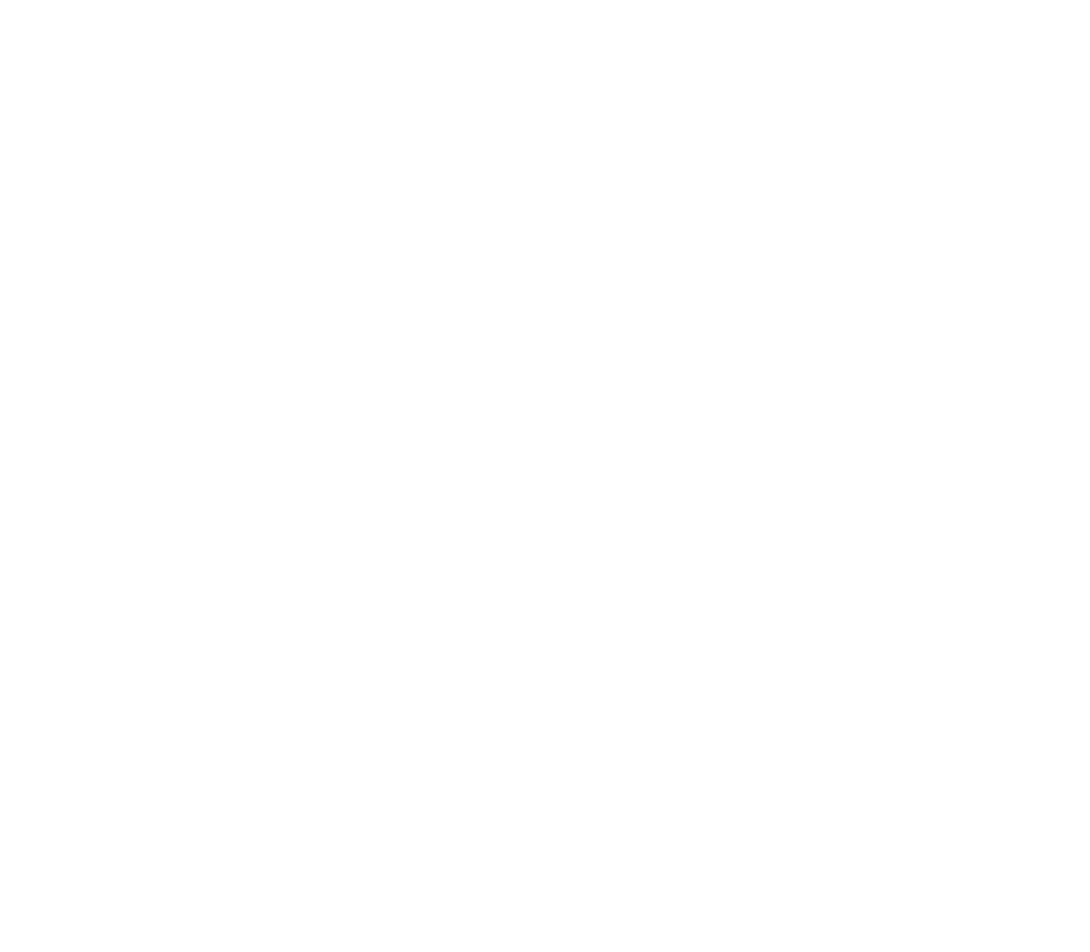
