The program offers an opportunity for artistic students to further their current artistic study and to participate in an artist youth community. FAME classes of music, visual arts, drama and dance are offered for campers. Daily talent sharing provides ample opportunities for performance, fun and camaraderie.

FAME will hold this camp in Howe, Indiana at Camp Lutherwald, to provide this artist colony experience to nominated young artists. The cost for the week-long overnight camp is \$450 and includes class fees, room and board, and a t-shirt.
